X2 Caddis

Hook: Dry fly hook, #14-18

<u>Thread:</u> Tan 70 denier <u>Shuck:</u> Caddis gold

<u>Abdomen:</u> Hares Ear, Olive, Tan, Black Head: Hares Ear, Olive, Tan, Black

Wing: Deer hair or carabou Underwing: White Zelon

Begin by placing a barbless hook into the vice. Begin wrapping thread just behind the hook eye, continue to bend of hook. Tie in shuck material and trim off to ½ the shank length. Tie in a single strand of pearl Krystal Flash. Dub the tying thread with Hares ear dubbing (color of choice) and wrap to 1/3 hook length from the hook eye. Now wind the rib material forward to the same point and tie off. Put the underwing in place and tie in. This should be as long as the body. Next cut a small bundle of deer hair and stack it to even ends. Tie the hair in place with several wraps. Again, dub the thread with Hares ear of a color a bit darker then the body. Tie off and apply head cement.
